4. Marketing Report

- Easter Wrap Up committee agreed that this was a well attended event with the activities encouraging people to walk around the shops (Easter sticker hunt), and the Trackless Train was very popular. There was also craft activities. Banners acknowledging the Macleod Village sponsorship were purchased in time for the event and erected on the day.
- All Aboard School Holiday event due the popularity of this event in July, 2018
 the committee agreed to proceed with this idea. There will be four other shopping
 centres participating, namely Watsonia, Rosanna, Eaglemont and Heidelberg. H
 Crundwell to approach businesses to see who would like to participate this year.
- **Macleod Park** The launch will be held on Saturday, 25th May and the Association is promoting it heavily on social media etc.
- **Social Media** committee agreed that this can continue to be done in house and the new co ordinator will manage. N Radman and N Sadiku also act as administrators.
- Safe Plates on hold until the new Co-ordinator commences.
- Christmas Fair H Crundwell asked the committee if they would like to see the Christmas Fair organised for a Friday (twilight) or Saturday. The committee had mixed opinion and was not confirmed.

- Marketing Proposal discussion was held around hosting a Car Boot Sale in Macleod Park.
- Banyule Senior Councils the new Co-ordinator is to explore how to make new connections with this group leading up to Senior Citizens Week. We could tap into the local Probus groups, etc and offer seniors discounts.
- Melbourne City N Sadiku to follow up with F Ciccone. Last year's involvement by Melbourne City was disappointing and the sign up and drills to be organised by Melbourne City must be in Macleod Park opposite our shops, otherwise there is no point in the Macleod Co-ordinator promoting this event.
